10:00 - **The Boundless Frontier** is a behind-the-scenes look at the engineering, science and technology that make subsea work so compelling. This session is aimed at young people, school pupils and students.

Dr. Joe MacInnis is a physician-scientist who studies leadership in high-risk environments. His latest book, *Deep Leadership*, is published by Random House. He has worked on offshore oil platforms in the North Sea and the Gulf of Mexico. He has led 10 research expeditions under the ice of the Arctic Ocean. In 2012, Dr. MacInnis was the team physician on James Cameron's Deepsea Challenge expedition.

In this 50-minute presentation he uses dramatic photographs and video clips to take you on a subsea journey that includes his first dive to the Titanic and the challenge of leading a \$5-million expedition to film the world's most famous shipwreck in the Imax format. He tells the riveting story of the leadership that led to James Cameron's successful seven-mile dive into the Mariana Trench.
